The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	16 th March 2022
(There must be a minimum period of 3 weeks between this date and the commencement date	
for accepting applications for admission)	
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	8th April 2022
(This date must be within 3 weeks of the closing date for receipt of application or within 3	
weeks of the application date for late applications)	
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	25 th April 2022 to

*Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

This school shall admit each student seeking admission except where -
